

Application Checklist

- Successful completion of a bachelor's degree by an accredited institution with a GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- International applicants must submit a evaluation of their academic transcripts for compatibility with the U.S. grading system. Reports must contain degree equivalency and grade point average.
- KU Graduate School Application (Domestic or International)
- KU-MPH Application
- Personal Statement
- Resume/CV
- 2 Copies of All Undergraduate and Post-baccalaureate Transcripts
- Standardized tests scores less than 5 years old (GRE, GMAT, LSAT, DAT, MCAT or USMLE Steps 1 & 2). *Standardized test scores are waived for those applicants with terminal degrees (MD, PhD, DO, DVM, etc).*
- Applicants whose citizenship is [not of the U.S.] and/or whose native language is not English must obtain an official Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score of 23 on each subsection of the computer-based TOEFL or 57 on each part of the paper-based TOEFL and an essay score of 5.0.
- Successful completion of College Algebra or Calculus
- One or more years of responsible work in the health field (preferred)
- 3 Letters of Recommendation with Recommendation Form
- \$35 Application Fee Payable to KUMC
